

LIBRIS Quick Guide <http://libris.kb.se/>

The national search service LIBRIS provides information on books, periodicals, articles, printed music, posters, maps and electronic resources in Swedish university and research libraries as well as some public libraries. We show you how to obtain the material in full text, or through local or inter-library loans.

SEARCH – enter search terms in the search box.

Truncate with an asterisk (*). Search for exact phrases by placing the phrase within quotation marks (").

FIND AND CHOOSE – you can refine your hit list in the right-hand menu to obtain fewer hits. Freely accessible full-text documents are shown in the hitlist.

SAVE AND CREATE REFERENCES – you can save references about records to use for citations. Choose save, cite, email or permalink. You can create references in different citation styles.

FIND AND BORROW – you can see which publications are available at the libraries. The map feature shows you where the libraries are situated in Sweden.

Loan status or the link **Title** in the library's local catalogue show you if the title is available for loan.

The tab **Other editions** shows you if the book is available in other editions, in another language or if it is published as an e-book.

What if your library does not own the title you are looking for? Check the tab **Interlibrary loan/Request** to see if your chosen favourite library has a request form.
